A message from our Ministerial Team

When a life-altering event occurs, we sometimes say, "We had a reality check." The story of Prince Siddhartha, for instance, is that he grew up insulated from poverty, illness, and death. Yet after



witnessing the harsh world beyond his palace walls, he was inspired to seek the solution to suffering, ultimately leading to his becoming the "Buddha" or awakened one.

Perhaps a more typical human experience is to settle on a particular worldview, one that resists evolving despite daily opportunities for insights and growth. Depending upon our upbringing, we may insist that Earth is only five or six thousand years old according to the Old Testament, or we may agree with the mountain of scientific evidence that the Earth formed billions of years ago. Yet how many of us can honestly say we've released every not-entirely-true belief or limiting attitude we've ever adopted?

As Unity students, we are naturally inclined toward making the world a better, brighter place, and doing our best to take care of each other and the planet we share. But until we find firm footing in daily practices that can expand our spiritual awareness, the limitations and barriers in our thoughts tend to express as limitations and barriers in our outer world. Thus, the ancient saying "As within, so without."

Still, if ever the winds of change were blowing, they seem to be blowing now. Perhaps we are nearing the point when society as a whole realizes that the nature of the world is change itself — that the only stable ground we can reliably stand upon is the invisible Ground of Being, that Power and Presence we call God, Spirit, Divine Consciousness, and many other names. Yet regardless of the path society takes, we can each take practical steps here and now toward spiritual awakening.

And so we dedicate this first month of this new year to the *new* world – the Higher Reality – awaiting discovery within our very souls.
