


Tuesday, May 14: *The Magnificent Ambersons,* directed by Orson Welles. (88 min.)

While Johan and Esther are both taciturn by nature, a moral dilemma is tearing Johan apart – he's been having an affair with another woman in their circle and feels he may be falling in love with her. While the tenets of his faith strictly

forbid adultery, his need to be with her seems stronger than the dictates of his moral compass, and while he's confessed his sins to Esther and his close friend, Zacarias, subjecting himself to the shame of truth hasn't buffered his desires. Even worse, after Johan confesses to his father about his lust for Marianne, he's told that he may have fallen under the sway of Satan.
