SERVICES IN SEPTEMBER

Sunday, September 3: "How Do We Grow from Here?" Speaker: Rev. Sherry Lady. In order to grow, plants need to root in the soil best suited for them and don't flourish well in unsuitable environments. As human beings we are more flexible and can adapt to many different environments. This often leads us to new opportunities for growth spiritually. Let's take a brief look at some of the challenges that come with this process, including adaptive strategies.

Sunday, September 10: "The Deep Waters of Emotional Calm." Speaker: Jon West. Sometimes our emotions seem to control us rather than the reverse. The Science of Calm is based on one simple idea: A calm, balanced nervous system is the foundation for a calm mind and a healthy body. It also sets the stage for deeper spiritual exploration.

Sunday, September 17: "Opening to Our Own Higher Consciousness." Speaker: Jon West. According to Unity philosophy, our true essence is literally Divine Consciousness individualized. What clues can we find from great mystics and even modern science to validate this and guide us toward unfolding our innate awareness of being?

Sunday, September 24: "Your Toolbox to Help You Grow." Speaker: Rev. Inge Tarantola. Unity offers many resources to help us grow spiritually. We would be wise to grow mentally and physically as well because we are whole beings, and each aspect supports the whole.


Contemplative Prayer allows us to delve more deeply into the silence, being present, and surrendering to our Higher Power. Come and explore this process with us in an experiential setting.

An Interview with Unity's Youth & Family Ministry Coordinator, Alice Sparks



Our Administrator, Géna Duel, sat down with **Alice Sparks** to chat about Unity's Youth & Family Ministry (YFM) and get a little more information about Alice to share with the congregation.

Alice has been coordinating YFM from home for over a year, but she officially started using the YFM office in May of this year.

When asked what inspired her to step up and volunteer to coordinate YFM, Alice said she was already teaching the youth and saw the need for guidance for the program so youth can experience spirit and all the things that go with love and kindness as well as teaching about Unity principles and how to utilize them in their lives. She also wants to see Unity grow. Youth programs bring families, and that helps the church grow.

We have been without a YFM Coordinator since the pandemic in 2020. We still had teachers stepping in, like Alice, but no one coordinating the program itself. The challenging part for Alice has been not having any of the past coordinators here to do training with. She has been learning as she goes. A great deal of her time has been spent going through the office materials and boxes of items to see what all age levels can use in their program, gathering information, meeting with the ministers, and teachers and helpers to bring organization and continuity to the YFM program.

The rewarding part for Alice is of course the youth. They inspire her and give her this internal drive and feeling of wanting to help them grow spiritually at whatever age level they are. She says: "In order to do that we have to have all the elements in place for our youth and families."

Alice has a deep sense of love and commitment to youth. She is honored to volunteer as the YFM coordinator and help the youth and families grow spiritually as well as teach prayer to the youth 2¹/₂ years old and up.

We are blessed to have Alice at Unity. Thank you for stepping up and volunteering Alice. We love you!

Back in the summer of 2020, a miracle occurred. As much of the world shut down and people began to fear for the future, one very special Unity couple did just the opposite. They had the faith and the vision to see past the turmoil. They opened their hearts and their hands, and they worked with the Oregon

Community Foundation (OCF) to create an endowment fund to benefit Unity of the Valley's music program. What an amazing gift!

This endowment is truly the gift that keeps on giving, as each July we receive a generous payment. OCF invests the original Endowment into a permanent pool with other Donor Funds. Every year they distribute half of our annual gains to Unity, and reinvest the other half. Both the Endowment and the Payouts will continue to increase each year permanently. So far, after 3 years, the payouts have already totaled \$8,315.

For all this time, I have been longing to share the names of the wonderful couple, to thank them openly for what they have done. I am overjoyed today to let you know that I have finally been given permission to do this!
